## Outstanding Performance Award Recipient

The Mukilteo Water and Wastewater District's Wastewater Treatment Facility was honored by the Department of Ecology for the 10<sup>th</sup> consecutive year. The Treatment Facility received the "2022 Outstanding Performance Award", recognized for achieving excellent compliance with water quality permits.

Each year the Department of Ecology evaluates wastewater treatment facilities on permit conditions such as meeting numeric effluent limits, conducting monitoring, and reporting data as state law requires. This award represents the staff's commitment and dedication to the operation and maintenance of the treatment facility and the part they play in keeping our environment clean.

Wastewater Treatment Facility Supervisor Darin Janda said, "The Outstanding Performance Award is presented to the Wastewater Treatment Facility, but truly belongs to the people of Mukilteo and our service area. It is an assurance that the professional staff at the District have done their best to protect the health of our customers and the environment."

## WATER CONSERVATION TIPS

### Outdoor water conservation

- ◆ Water early or late in the day
- ◆ Water deeply but infrequently
- ◆ Get water to the roots
- ◆ Fix leaks
- ◆ Wash vehicles with a pail and a hose with a shut-off nozzle or at a car wash
- ◆ Use a broom, not a hose, for cleaning
- ◆ Tune-up automatic sprinkler systems
- ◆ Mow lawns high
- ◆ Water young trees efficiently
- ◆ Use shut-off nozzles on hoses

### Indoor residential water conservation

- ◆ Replace older toilets with Water Sense labeled high-efficiency toilets

- ◆ Take shorter showers
- ◆ Fix leaks promptly
- ◆ Wash full loads of laundry and dishes
- ◆ Turn off the tap when brushing your teeth and washing your hands
- ◆ Use garbage disposal minimally


### Indoor business water conservation

- ◆ Fix leaks promptly
- ◆ Wash full loads of laundry and dishes
- ◆ Thaw food in the fridge
- ◆ Provide towels on request
- ◆ Check cooling towers
- ◆ Check the equipment that is not in use
- ◆ Increase employee awareness

#### Water Efficient Faucet Aerators

Install aerators to save water & energy by producing forceful water-streams regardless of water pressure.



#### 1.75 GPM Chrome Showerheads

Install a "low-flow" showerhead and use up to 75% less water in the shower. Take a shorter shower and save even more water.



#### Pipe Tape

Pipe tape permits quick, clean & economical pipe sealing.

#### Toilet Dye Strips

Fixing a leaky toilet conserves water and saves money. Leaking toilets waste more water than any other household fixture.

#### 7-Spray Deluxe Hose Nozzle

Use a hose with a shut-off nozzle when watering by hand to avoid letting water run down the sidewalk or driveway.



#### Outdoor Automatic Shut-off Timer

Attach an automatic shut-off timer to your hose bibb to avoid over-watering. Your lawn only needs about 1 inch of water per week including rainfall.



#### Moisture Meters: Frog or Ladybug

Monitor the amount of moisture in your soil with a decorative moisture meter.
